ICL 25th Year 2019: At our last AGM the committee was tasked with preparations for our 25th year which will be in 2019. We have agreed to put aside one day to have a dedicated competition. The date being 25th September 2019. Initially, we would suggest every club enter a team of seven players who have participated in at least three league matches. The format to be two three ball bowmakers, with the scores added together and the seventh person to do an individual to add a bit of spice. The cost per person would be £12. It would be great if your committee's could consider taking care of your clubs entry. I can then secure the entries at the next AGM and have sufficient funds to put this in place. Due to the fact I and the committee will be taking care of the organising we have agreed the venue can be at Wheathill.

Judith Sperring suggested that it would be nice to repeat the exercise every 5 years. This was agreed.

SALTFORD – after the Worlebury application to join the ICL, another application was received in early October from Saltford. A full discussion took place as to whether to admit Saltford for the 2018 season or the 2019 one. It was felt that as many clubs had already organised their schedule for 2018, it was too late to admit Saltford. It was unanimously agreed that Saltford would be most welcome to join us for the 2019 season. This was proposed by Sonia Probert (Orchardleigh) and seconded by Sue Bamping (Wheathill).
